## IOTA ADVISORS' UPDATE

This school year has been a challenging one for our undergraduate brothers.

Given that most of their classes have been virtual, they have been severely restricted on what types and sizes of events they could hold, along with the physical and mental health issues it will be a year that we look forward to putting behind us. Thankfully we had no one get seriously ill. The chapter did reasonably well in recruitment, but this coming fall will be a crucial one as we seek to once again grow with quality back to a brotherhood of around 100 brothers. We did have brothers leave school and some left our brotherhood given the restrictions on our programming.

The chapter did win the Best Recruitment Award along with Jackson Spear being recognized as the Best House Director by the Office of Fraternity and Sorority Life. The chapter has raised nearly \$5,000 for Children's Miracle Network and the brothers donated over \$1,000 to the Zeta Beta Tau Foundation. The brothers did conduct a blood drive as well as putting in lots of hours at a local food bank. Arthur Ashworth is serving as an IFC Vice-President.

The brother's cumulative GPA for fall quarter was an impressive 3.42!

We thank Alec Hurst and his leadership for their efforts during the first portion of this school year and look forward to continuing to work with Alex Murphy and his team in the months to come.

We are pleased to welcome Marc Goldenberg and Matt Meyer to our House Corporation Board. They will be excellent additions. We want to thank our other house corporation directors and advisors for their help during this school year.

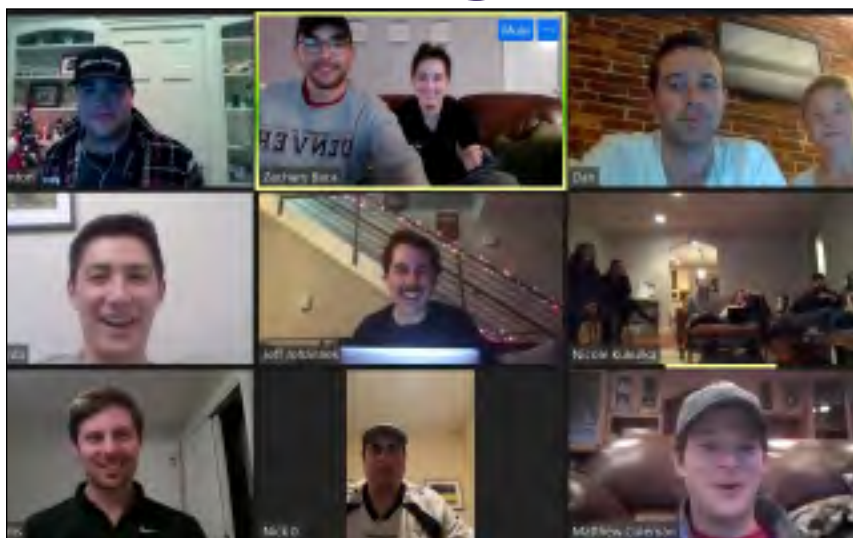


# Zoom Trivia Game Night

# ZBT Israeli Ambassador Ron Dermer



The Zeta Beta Tau Foundation is proud to bring virtual programming to brothers and friends of ZBT. One of the recent events included an off-the-record conversation with Israeli Ambassador to the United States Ron Dermer, Theta (University of Pennsylvania) 1993 attended by nearly 400 alumni and undergraduates.

*Editor's note: The program with Ambassador Dermer was not recorded as it was an off the record conversation.*

Ron Dermer (born April 16, 1971) is an American-born Israeli political consultant and diplomat who served as the Israeli Ambassador to the United States. He previously served as Israel's economic envoy to the United States from 2005 to 2008, a position requiring him to give up his American citizenship, and subsequently served as senior adviser to current Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu for four years. On July 9, 2013 Dermer was confirmed by the government of Israel as Israel's ambassador to the United States, replacing Michael Oren. He began serving as Israel's Ambassador to the United States in October 2013. In July 2019, it was announced that the Israeli Civil Service Commission would not extend his term and that Dermer will resign as Ambassador to the United States in September 2019. In January 2021 Dermer stopped serving as the ambassador and Gilad Erdan replaced him.

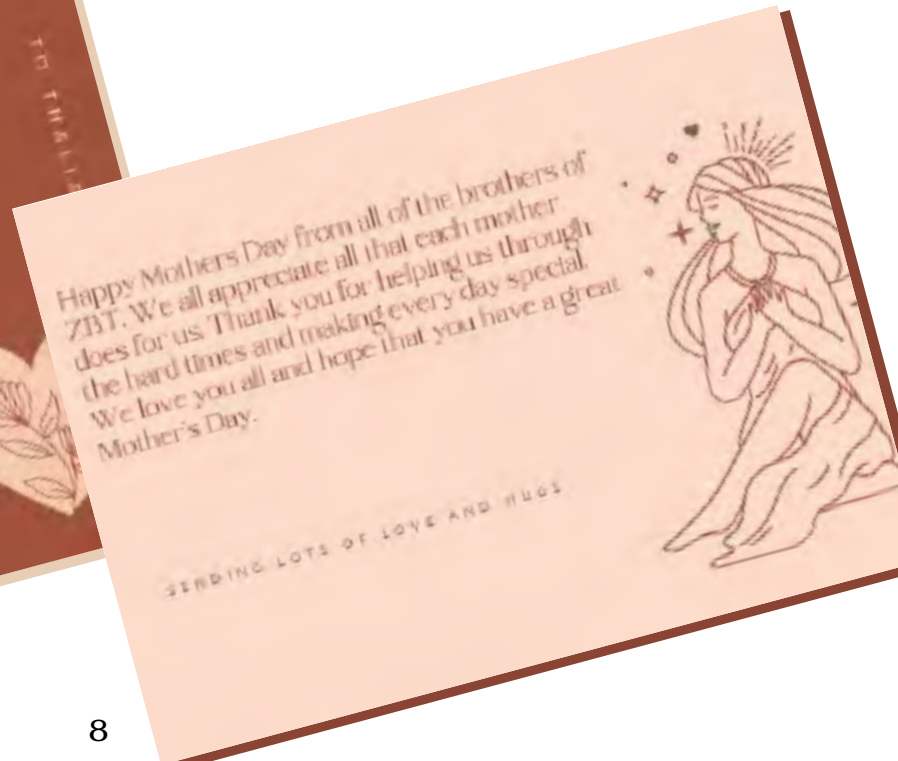

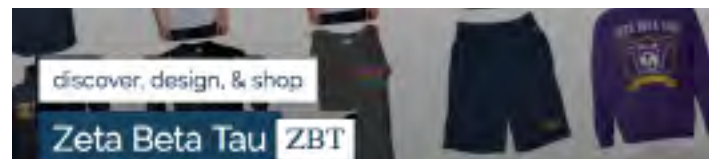
